- “Regular Business” means any resident business that has a gross annual revenue generated within the Kananaskis Improvement District between \$10,000 and \$ 750,000.
- “Major Business” means any business that has gross annual revenue generated within the Kananaskis Improvement District of \$ 750,000 or greater.
