## **Lieutenant – Casual Position**

**Kananaskis Improvement District - Emergency Services -** Kananaskis Emergency Services is seeking a highly motivated, team player to fill this position. Reporting to the Chief of Emergency Services or Station Officer, the Lieutenant is responsible on an as needed basis for all fire and rescue operations and operational assignments as provided from the Kananaskis Emergency Services Centre. This will include emergency and non-emergency operations as related to structural fire suppression, vehicle rescue, emergency medical services, structural rescue, hazardous material interventions, wildland urban interface, wildland fire suppression, backcountry / slope rescue, and ice rescue operations, structural and confined space rescue. Supervision and training of Paid on Call Firefighter staff, fire prevention and education duties, general and preventative maintenance of equipment, vehicles and facilities and ensuring the readiness of emergency response equipment, assisting in dispatching of after hours emergencies and inter-agency assistance to other emergency services agencies are all key functions of this position.

**Qualifications:** High School Diploma plus completion of the NFPA Firefighter series 1001 – Level 1 and 2 and two years related experience, current ACP Emergency Medical Responder certification, a valid Class 3/4 Alberta Operators License with air brake endorsement with less than 6 demerit points. Preference will be given to applicants that have completed NFPA 1002, NFPA 1021 level 1, NFPA 1041, NFPA 1051, a demonstrated knowledge of the Kananaskis Improvement District and have completed an accredited Defensive Driving Course. Experience with Microsoft Office programs such as Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint and Word would be an asset. The candidate shall demonstrate good interpersonal and communication skills, both written and oral. Housing is not available within the Kananaskis Improvement District.
