This course is available to members of recognized emergency services organizations. This course is being delivered over two weekends with a Friday start on the first weekend, the exam and practical evaluations will be on July 6, 2025, at the Kananaskis Emergency Services Centre. The apparatus operator has an important role and has significant responsibility for not only those in the vehicle, but the general public as well. And once on scene, the operator must be able to efficiently and effectively operate all components of the apparatus (not just the pump). The driver of the vehicle has the role and responsibility to check and perform routine maintenance on apparatus as per department operating guidelines. This course provides you with the basic knowledge and skills to drive and maintain a fire apparatus safely. Content includes:

Chapter 1 – 4 of NFPA 1002: Types of apparatus equipped with a pump, apparatus inspection and maintenance, apparatus safety and operating emergency vehicle, and positioning apparatus.

Students will be required to purchase their own textbook: IFSTA Pumping and Aerial Apparatus Driver 3rd Edition. The textbook is available from the Alberta Fire Chief's Association bookstore (link is below).
